


EU farm sector - needs for training

Low share of farmers with adequate agricultural training:

Formal training / education in farm sector (2010):

- 29 % of farmers in EU
- 48 % in FU-15
- 15 % in EU-N12



→ Insufficient managerial skills at farm level

Support for Advisory Services in RDP 2014-2020

Purpose of the measure

- help farmers, forest-holders, SMEs in rural areas to use advisory services
 - > for better economic or environmental / climate-related performance
- promote the **setting-up** of farm management, farm relief, farm advisory services and forestry advisory services
- promote the training of advisors / trainers

Forms of advice (individual and/or group) and possible areas

- Farm modernisation, competitiveness building, innovation, market orientation
- Obligations at farm level deriving from EU rules
- Agricultural practices beneficial for the climate and the environment
- Requirements for implementing Water Framework Directive
- Occupational safety standards
- Specific advice for farmers setting for the first time



Support for Knowledge Transfer in RDP 2014-2020

Purpose of the measure

to feed the capacity to innovate by bringing farms and other rural businesses more fully into the knowledge economy

Forms of support

- Vocational training and skills acquisition, e.g. training courses, workshops, coaching
- Demonstration activities
- Short-term farm exchange or visit schemes

Forms of training sessions

- Specific sessions (e.g. farm accountancy, short-supply chains, renewable energy sources, water & energy efficiency, organic farming, ICT)
- E-learning training courses
- Training which form part of normal education programmes are excluded


Key facts and figures (2014-20)

1 983 Operational Groups under the EIP







Georgia: support for advisory services - a core aspect

Armenia: improve agricultural workers skills and knowledge

Moldova: improved education research and advisory services

Technical assitance: integral component of any sector programme, incl. through TAIEX (short term missions and visits, workshops) or Twinning (long term secondment of EU Member State experts to the national administrations). Possibility of ad hoc technical assistance in particular for DCFTA related requirements.
