

69% of the territory of Latvia is green

Latvian agriculture is extensive/conventional in nature. Latvia is No 5 from the end in terms of use of fertilizers, hence, green – organic products are grown in Latvia.


According to the environmental indicators of the Yale Univ. and Univ. of Columbia, Latvia became the 2nd greenest country in the world.

Total output in 2012 – 1.6 млрд. USD




94% Latvian municipalities declared themselves free of GMOs.

16% are fit for cattle farming, vegetation period in Latvia is 5 months, no need for additional feed as pastures are available.







Total number of food producers – 731 Total Output in 2013 - USD 1.9 billion




Quality of food products meet high EU standards.

Briefly about LRATC

Latvian Rural Advisory and Training Centre (LRATC) was founded on February 1, 1991

1991 – 1997 State budgetary institution

1997 – 2004 Non-profit organization

2004 – onwards Limited Liability Company

Company owners:

- 1% of basic assets owned by the LATVIAN FARMERS FEDERATION
- 99% of basic capital is owned by the government Structure of the Company:
- National center
- Regional centers for rural development (26 district bureaus) and for development of services at 26 district bureaus

1991 - 1997

Owner – State budgetary institution Services:

- Individual purchase and sales services;
- Accounting;
- Individual professional consultations;
- Trainings
- Development projects



1997 - 2004

Non-profit organization

Project Goal – gaining new experience related to LEADER practices in other countries and activities of local initiative groups. In the framework of the project many rural development experts visited Netherlands



Development of Rural Environment

INTERREG IIC Project - European Network of Rural Advisers / RENE)

Goal of the Project – facilitate exchange of information, experience, and knowledge about the tools, which facilitate development in the European countries as well as problems in the rural areas. In the framework of the project, LRATC experts visited many activities to share international experience and organized international meetings in Latvia with the institutions related to rural development and extension



Development of Rural Environment

INTERREG IIIC Active Learning for Identity and Competence of European Rural Areas / ALICERA)

In collaboration with 7 institutions, which facilitate development in the rural environment (in Austria, France, Latvia, Hungary and Germany).

Project Goal – strengthening link between urban and rural residents and educating urban residents about rural processes. Project implementation in collaboration with Extension centers of Tukums, Jelgava, Limbazi, Valmiera and Valka.

As a result of the project, a network consisting of over 60 sites was created, offering stakeholders introduction into 6 different themes, e.g. "From seed to bread"


