Provide advocacy and leadership on rural advisory services within the global development agenda




GFRAS Functions

- 3. Strengthening capacity of actors and fora in RAS through facilitating interaction and networking




GFRAS Structure

What is the "New Extensionist"

- A global view of extension and advisory services (EAS) clearly articulating and reinventing its expanded role within agricultural innovation systems (AIS).
- A look beyond strengthening individual skills at organisations and systems and their capacities.



Why the "New Extensionist"

Clarifying the important role of EAS in enabling agricultural innovation

Advocating for strengthening EAS at different levels so that it contributes better to agricultural development
