The aim and content (1)

The aim:

CECR

Standardized trainings to develop the skills of consultants who are working in rural areas.

-> methodological training + see the bigger picture

The content:

- 2 compulsory modules:
 - Personality development /advisory profile
 - Communication / customer relation

In addition to the two compulsory modules, three out of the 13 elective modules must be chosen.

The elective modules (1):

- Working in and leading in a team
- Rhetoric / presentation skills
- Self and time management
- Project management / project advising
- Arrangement of consulting processes
- Dealing with difficult consulting situations / change management



The elective modules (2):

- Moderation and meeting management
- Marketing / public relations
- Management of education and events
- Advising and accompanying groups
- Essentials of mediation
- Consulting and assisting enterprises in strategic questions
- Coaching Introduction



The other conditions for the certificate are:

- completed vocational training
- two years of professional experience in advising
- participation in
 - an event in another country
 - a visit to a counseling service in another country
 - to complete a case study (self-reflection).

for European Consultants The benefit to the consultants

- Acquisition of methodical, communicative and social skills and competences beyond personal development
- Reflection of the professional activity in various advisory roles
- Ability to anticipate, implement, document, reflect and evaluate independent advices, educational events and projects
- Participation in the functional and transnational network

The benefits to the institutions

- Professionalism means
 expertise + professional consulting activities
- Employers have employees who have a wider horizon
- The effectiveness of counselling depends according to the literature very much on the personality of the consultant (cf. CECRA Module 1)
- Employers provide evidence to customers, regulators or funding agencies to employ qualified personnel
- Positive image for the consulting organization

The benefits to the institutions

- Neutral, by the public sector issued certificate, affects the customer more
- Qualification as a confidence-building measure at the customer
- CECRA graduates
 - develop an understanding of the specifics of
 - the rural areas
 - the total operational contexts
 - the social constraints of the family business
 - can manage themselves, customers and projects
