





Organic farms and area



2011 1431 farms 134 057 ha





What kind of education and educational materials are offered?

- No curricula in university or vocational education, only single subjects – basic principles of organic farming, organic animal husbandry, in other subjects just certain aspects of organic farming
- Nova-Bova University master courses in organic farming for Baltic students (2 weeks courses)
- Short 1-2 days trainings
- Study trips (local and abroad)
- Informational booklets, handbook, guidelines, magazine





- There is training requirement in organic farming support scheme -2 days in the first year of conversion, 2 days additional training in 5-years period
- All trainings are free of charge
- Information materials (incl. Organic Farming Magazine) are free of charge
- Study trips include own contribution





Short trainings 1

- Procurements by the Ministry of Agriculture (yearly 2009-2011):
 - Regular information days for those, who are planning the conversion (in total 10 days)
 - Regular 2-days trainings for farmers starting the conversion. (in total 14 days)
 - Regular short 1-day trainings (different topics, in total 24 days)
 - Other short 1-2 days trainings (incl. with foreign lecturer, up to 10 days)





Short trainings 2

 Other trainings (mostly 1-2 days) depending of the initiative of different organisations (ca 40-60 days)





Short trainings 3

- Total number of training days yearly ca 100
- Total human days of trainings yearly ca 2500





Study trips

- 2009 Denmark
- 2010 Austria
- 2011 France, Finland
- planned in 2012 Germany, Sweden, Finland
- + trips incl. some organic aspects
- + local trips
 Topics production,
 processing, marketing

Topics covered

Mainly:

- Organic plant production, incl. on farm trainings
- Organic animal production, incl. on farm trainings

- Processing, incl. practical trainings

- etc.







Financing of training 2009 / 2010

No special line for organic farming; no exact data

- Ordered by the ministry, RDP Technical assistance ca 15 000 €/ 40 000 €
- RDP Measure 1.1 Training and information activities ca 30 000 €/ 40 000 €
- Market development support, Estonian state budget (study trips) ca 18 000 € / 22 000 €
- Other sources ? €
- Average cost of the training day (local lecturers) 1000 €
